Drink cans, tins, bottle caps

Pans, tools, cutlery

Peel and remains of fruit and vegetables, including citrus fruit

Coffee grounds with filter papers

Tea and tea bags

Egg shells

Food leftovers, including cooked food

Old foodstuffs (without packaging)

Flowers

Garden waste, including grass clippings

Green waste and shrub cuttings

Leaves

Wrapping paper, e.g. old newspapers or kitchen paper

Sanitary products

Sanitary paper

Dishes

Vacuum cleaner bags

Paper, dirty or coated

Animal litter

Nappies

Wallpaper remnants

Foil, dirty

Paint, dried up

Sweepings, brushed-up material

Ashes and ashtray contents
